

# HEART SURGERY CANCELLED

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My name is Natalie Pavliv, am 60 years old and live in Toronto, Ontario, Canada. This is my testimony of how prayer to the Mother of God helped me at my time of need.

In August 2023, suddenly late one Saturday evening, I felt great discomfort and pain in my chest area. I have never had such pain previously in my life and was hoping that it would go away. But the pain in my chest persisted and became even more severe. My mother who was a retired registered head nurse, insisted that I go to the hospital immediately. Because of my great discomfort, I took her advice and went to the hospital emergency department.

I was examined and all kinds of tests were ordered, ECG etc., as my preliminary examination. according to the emergency physician, was showing alarming results. My severe chest pain was now also extending to my back.

Several hours later, more tests were performed and a cardiologist was summoned as all the tests indicated that I had suffered a mild heart attack due to some blockage in my arteries. I was immediately admitted to the cardiology hospital department.

The next day, the cardiologist told me that an angiogram test is absolutely necessary to find out the level and extent of the blockage and possible stenting procedures afterwards to keep my arteries open and functional. This was a total shock to me! I was in panic and could not believe that this was happening to me as there was no history ever of any heart problems in my family.

I was pleading with the specialist to just give me some medication and allow me to go home. The cardiologist emphatically stated that if the procedures that he mentioned previously are not done now, there was a huge probability that I would have a fatal attack very soon. At this time, I was pleased that someone was trying to save my life.



The following day, as I was praying and asking God for His help and mercy, I remembered the many people who were miraculously healed and helped by the genuine prayers of other people at the Shrine of Gratitude (in Toronto) and especially Dr. Michael Rozeluk, who came to the Shrine often, and who himself was miraculously healed with the Garabandal medal that was kissed by the Blessed Virgin Mary Herself. Together with his late wife, Helen, they often sacrificed their time and offered prayers for people's healings and problems. I decided to telephone him and I was so relieved to hear his voice on the phone. I explained my situation and asked him to plead to Mother Mary and Jesus on my behalf with his kissed Garabandal medal.



Hearing his genuine, deep, wholehearted prayer, while using his Garabandal medal, for me before the Throne of God and placing me into our Heavenly Mother's hands gave me more strength, hope and assurance that everything will be OK. After the prayers, Dr. Rozeluk said: *"Try to get some sleep. Believe that Mother Mary will intercede for you before God just like She did for others. Tomorrow the operating cardiologist will not find any blockages. Just trust God's Mercy especially when your Heavenly Mother is pleading for you!"*

The next day, I was transferred to St. Michael's Hospital in Toronto to have the angiogram done.

With mild sedation, I was able to observe how my arteries were examined from within. When the procedure was completed, the doctor announced that **he could not find any serious blockage in my arteries!**

The cardiologist looked somewhat puzzled and asked me: "Please tell me honestly, did you take some recreational drugs before the heart attack happened?" He simply just could not explain why my arteries were clean with no blockages after what had happened to me! I told him that I prayed for God's help and God answered! I was dismissed to go home, without any heart surgery, the next day on August 22nd when the church is celebrating the QUEENSHIP OF OUR HEAVENLY MOTHER MARY.

I am forever grateful for God's Mercy, Mother Mary's love and intercession and Her kiss on the Garabandal medal. I thank Dr. Rozeluk for his devoted prayers, his strong belief and kind heart.

P.S.: While in the ambulance that was transporting me to St. Michael's Hospital, through the window, I saw the statue of Our Lady that was very similar to the statue of Our Lady at the Shrine of Gratitude on Weston Road in Toronto. I knew She was with me and everything would be fine. AND IT WAS! Praise the Lord!
